

Love the Land Photo Contest 2017

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The contest will select 24 winning entries from across the NWT for the *CPAWS-NWT 2018 Love the Land Calendar*: 12 calendar page photos (one for each month) and 12 inset photos. We are looking for images from your time spent outdoors throughout the NWT.

An entrant may submit up to 5 photos to the contest.

Calendar page winners may be requested to submit a short narrative explaining how their photo(s) show love of the land, to accompany the photo(s) in the calendar.

Contest is open Monday, June 5th – Friday, September 22nd, 2017. Late entries not accepted. Mailed entries must be postmarked before **September 8th, 2017.**

Contest Theme:

We strongly encourage submissions that capture the uniqueness of northern landscapes and activities in each of the four seasons. Photos can be taken anywhere within the NWT, but they **MUST** either:

- a) feature people themselves on the land or water, or
- b) clearly evoke peoples' interactions with the land and water and/or show evidence of peoples' presence.

Contestants:

- Open to NWT residents and visitors
- Limit of 5 photos per contestant
- Contestants must have taken the photo themselves

Submission Details:

- Each entry must include:
 - Title of photo
 - The contestant's name, address and phone number

- Location and date the photo was taken
- If any people in your photo are recognizable, you MUST include a release form signed by each person (or their parent or guardian), with your entry. Entries without release forms will not be considered.
- Jpeg format
- Minimum resolution = 300 dpi
- Photos may be submitted in natural colour or black and white forms only. Minor digital enhancements, such as cropping, contrast, etc. are permitted. No watermarks, signatures or copyright notices may be added to the image.
- Submit to: nwtadmin@cpaws.org. Indicate 'Photo Contest' in the subject line
- If email is not an option, CDs can be mailed to CPAWS-NWT at PO Box 1934, Yellowknife NT, X1A 1T6. CDs will not be returned. CPAWS-NWT is not responsible for lost or damaged CDs.

Judging:

- The winners will be selected by a panel of judges. The decision of the judges is final.
- If your photo is selected:
 - It will appear either as a main calendar page or an inset for one of the 12 months in the *CPAWS-NWT 2018 Love the Land Calendar*;
 - It may appear on the CPAWS-NWT website (www.cpawsnwt.org), Facebook page, or other CPAWS-NWT written publications;
 - You will be acknowledged with a photo credit in all places your photo is published;
 - By entering the contest, you agree that any image you submit may be used by CPAWS-NWT for marketing and promotional purposes of this or future contests or other conservation-related work, including but not limited to:
 - the CPAWS-NWT website and Facebook page;
 - at public events to promote the competition or other initiatives;
 - in a book, newsletter, poster, calendar or postcard;
 - minor digital enhancements such as cropping, contrast and re-sizing the image as necessary, and
 - sub-licensing the image to the press for use in connection with the contest.
- If your photo is not selected, we may request to hold your image for a future year's contest.
- CPAWS-NWT reserves the right to refuse any photo that does not meet the photo specifications or adhere to contest rules, and reserves the right to terminate, cancel or suspend the contest without notice.
